## DISSEMINATING OF THE ACTIVITIES

### A. Evaluation and monitoring of project activities

1. All partner countries will apply a questionnaire to collect feedback from the beneficiaries of the project activities (Annex 1);
2. Results from the questionnaire will be used in the assessment tool and monitoring evolution of the phenomenon ESL (Annex 2);
3. ESL model for monitoring, will be used by each project partner;
4. Each partner will use Benchmarking Analysis for comparative evaluation of the project evolution (Annex 3);
5. It was achieved a comparison between rates of early school leaving, from the each partner country.



## **B. Sharing of experience and promotion of best practices**

1. The Psychological Counselors, from each country, made presentation about "Good communication ways between the teachers and the students" and their recommends;
2. Were made exchanges on methods and techniques used by teachers that could lead to positive results in work with students;
3. Have been identified activities that would attract the involvement of parents;
4. Have been identified resources that teachers could use in educational activities in order to attract students.

## **C. Virtual exchanges of experiences for students**

1. It was established that the exchange of experiences made in meetings of teaching and learning can be improved and through virtual space, in the form of a draft e-Twinning, through which students can communicate, can plan activities to be carried out in future meetings and teachers can identify common interests of their students.

## **D. Activities, Discussions and Decisions**

1. All the participants visited the two school buildings and the classrooms of the hosting school *Technological High School "Spiru Haret"*;
2. *Serbanescu Mihai Cristian* has proposed the model for monitoring early school leaving;
3. *Berivan Karadag* project coordinator, proposed to use of the model by each partner country;
4. *Serbanescu Mihai Cristian* proposed to use Benchmarking analysis for monitoring and evaluating progress of the project;
5. *Berivan Karadag* has established the structure for collecting feedback questionnaire;
6. *Jurate Jovaisiene* presented the activities being carried out in meeting the learning-teaching in Lithuania;
7. *Magdalena Kempisty* synthesized the feedback since the last meeting of the teaching-learning of the project;
8. *Berivan Karadag* has created e-Twinning project on the platform and invited all partners to participate;
9. The period for conducting the third transnational meeting (fifth meeting of project) in Poland will be: 14<sup>th</sup>-18<sup>th</sup> November 2016.
